Range Location: Shooting will take place in the Professional Security Services (PSS) Building, located about a mile from the Roanoke Civic Center. Address is 2203 Shenandoah Valley Ave., NE, off Plantation Road directions available on the back of this announcement or at www.pss-range.com

Rules: Current NRA BB Rifle Rules will govern

First Time Competitors: An Informational workshop will be held on July 19th at PSS Indoor Range and Training from 9 am till noon to include range orientation and position demonstration and practical exercise for those who have not competed before or are unsure of the rules. Please Call or email if planning on attending.

Competition Open to: Any Junior Shooter. Only Virginia Residents are eligible for the state title.

Registration Fee: \$15 for junior member & \$75 for a 5-member junior team
\$15 additional will be collected for those who desire their scores to be entered in the NRA Registered State Championship
Everyone **must** shoot as an individual and the team is a paper match

Relays: #1 at 1:00pm, #2 at 3:30 pm and if needed #3 at 6:00pm. If more relays are needed, we will add them to the morning, or possibly on Friday night.

Classification: Each competitor will be classified according to the NRA International Classification System and must exhibit a current classification card or score record book upon registration. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master Class.

Course of Fire: Ten (10) shots at each of the three (3) positions, in this order: Prone, Standing, and Kneeling. Time limit is fifteen (15) minutes prone and kneeling and twenty (20) minutes standing, all times include any sighters fired. One (1) AR4/10 targets will be hung at a time, by staff for each position.

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented to the first three places. NRA award points will be presented to all winners. The state champion will be awarded a certificate from the NRA for the title.
