Range Location: Shooting will take place in back of the Professional Security Services (PSS) Building, located about a mile from the Roanoke Civic Center. Address is 2203 Shenandoah Valley Ave., NE, off Plantation Road directions available on the back of this announcement or at www.pss-range.com

Rules: Current NRA Air Rifle Silhouette Rules will govern

First Time Competitors: Informal competition preceded with an instructional and zero session will be conducted prior to competition. Call above contact person to confirm activity. Club equipment is available for use by non-club members for a minimal fee.

Competition Open to: Anyone, only Virginia residents are eligible for state champion title.

Registration Fee: \$15 for junior member & \$75 for a 5-member team
\$15 additional will be collected for those who desire their scores to be entered in the NRA Registered State Championship. Everyone must shoot as an individual and the team is a paper match

Relays: #1 at 1:00pm, #2 at 2:00 pm and if needed #3 at 3:00pm. If more relays are needed, we will add them to the morning.

Classification: NRA classification system, using their classification book. Everyone shooting is required to have (or purchase) a classification book. Price is \$12; good for the entire year.

Equipment: Unless sufficient participation warrants, all will shoot the open category; per NRA rules, any air rifle weighing no more than 16lbs, with scope and mount. A vest used for trap and skeet may be worn, but no padding to provide artificial support is allowed. Clothing appropriate for the weather is allowed, to include gloves. Use of a sling is not permitted.

Position: Any standing position, without support. See rule book for illustrations.

Course of Fire: Twenty (20) shots at each of the four (4) animals: Gallina (chicken) at 20 yds, Javelina (pig) at 30 yds, Guajalote (turkey) at 36 yds and Borrego (ram) at 45 yards. Sighters will be allowed during the preparation period at each animal (only at sighting target). A time limit of 2 minutes and 30 seconds will be allowed to fire at each bank of 5 animals.

Awards: *Cash or NRA points will be awarded.*
